A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SECURING THE PAYMENT OF \$1,900,000 SEWER REVENUE BONDS OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD, IOWA, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE CITY CODE OF IOWA, AND PROVIDING FOR A METHOD OF PAYMENT OF SAID BONDS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood, Iowa, sometimes hereinafter referred to as the "Issuer", has heretofore established charges, rates and rentals for services which are and will continue to be collected as system revenues of the Municipal Sewer Utility, sometimes hereinafter referred to as the "System", and said revenues have not been pledged and are available for the payment of Revenue Bonds, subject to the following premises; and

WHEREAS, Issuer proposes to issue its Revenue Bonds to the extent of \$1,900,000 for the purpose of defraying the costs of the project as set forth in Section 3 of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, during the course of construction of such project Revenue Pledge Orders, bearing interest, were issued from time to time to the respective persons furnishing materials and services constituting the project under the terms of contracts therefor, on estimates approved by the Consulting Engineer for work performed and materials furnished or to persons providing services in connection with the project and said Revenue Pledge Orders, together with accrued interest computed to the date of the Bonds hereinafter authorized and project costs to be met directly from bond proceeds now exceed the principal amount of the bonds herein authorized and which to the extent of said Pledge Orders and interest should now be refunded; and
