ORDINANCE NO. 5386

AN ORDINANCE vacating the alleys in Block 32, Mills' Second Addition to University Place being the block between 1st Street and 52nd Street and between Melrose Street and Aylesworth Street, reserving certain rights and privileges to the City of Lincoln in said alley so vacated, and providing for the filing of a copy of this ordinance with the Register of Deeds of Lancaster County, Nebraska.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

Section 1. That the alleys in Block 32, Mills' Second Addition to University Place, Lincoln, Nebraska, being the block between 1st Street and 52nd Street and between Melrose Street and Aylesworth Street, be and it hereby is vacated upon the following conditions:

That the City of Lincoln reserves the right of way through and in said alleys so vacated for all sewers and water pipes, all electric wires, electric pole lines, telephone and telegraph lines and telephone and telegraph wires, and all underground conduits now located therein or which the City of Lincoln may hereafter direct to be located therein, either for its own use and behalf or for the use and behalf of holders of franchises heretofore granted or hereafter granted by said City of Lincoln, and reserves the right of way to enter said alleys so vacated for itself and the holders of said franchises, at any time, for the construction, maintenance and repair of such sewers, water pipes, electric wires, electric pole lines, telephone and telegraph lines, telephone and telegraph poles, and underground conduits. No building shall be erected in said alleys so vacated.

Section 2. Immediately upon the taking effect of this ordinance the City Clerk shall file a certified copy hereof in the office of the Register of Deeds of Lancaster County, Nebraska.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law.
