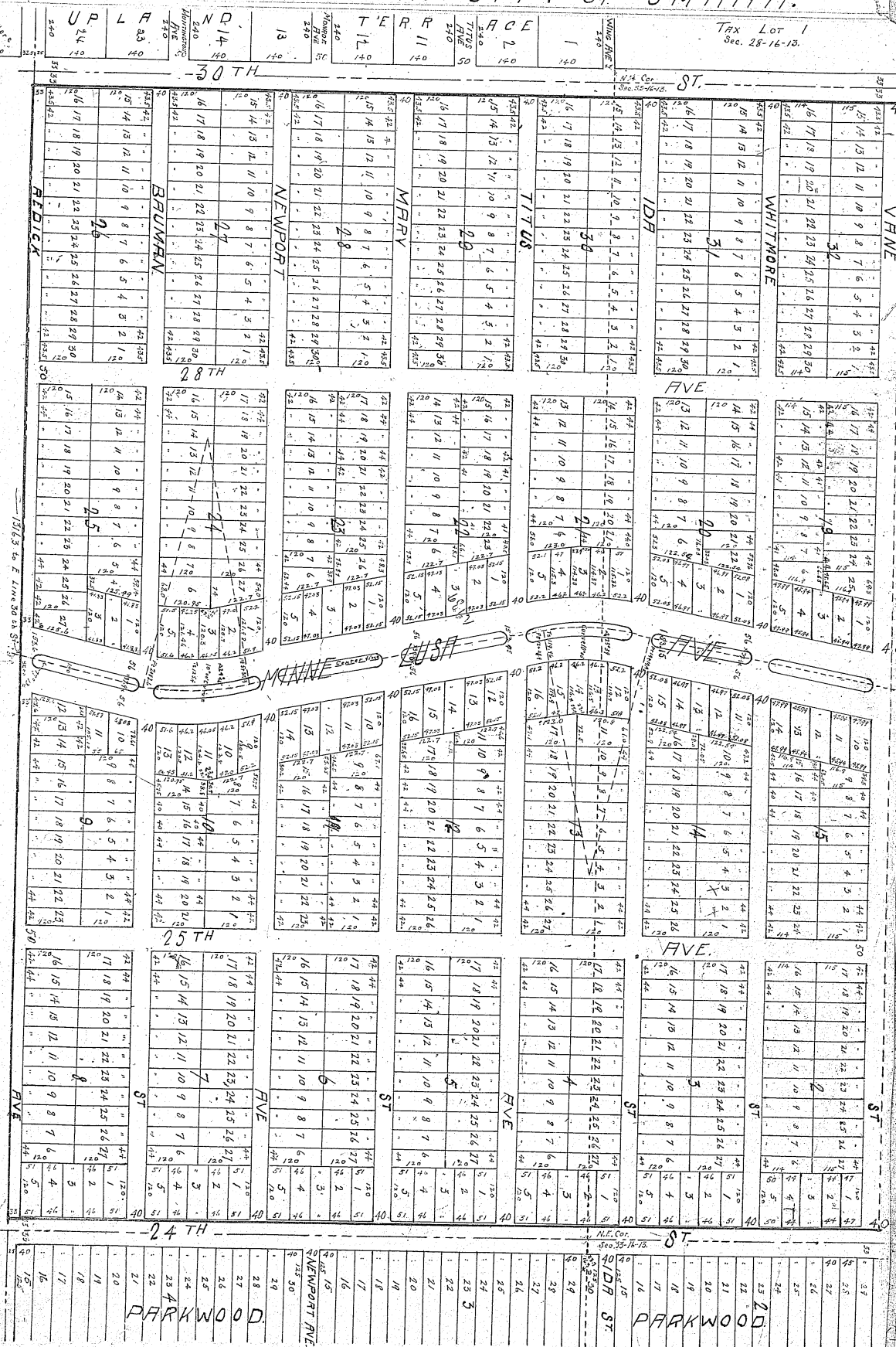


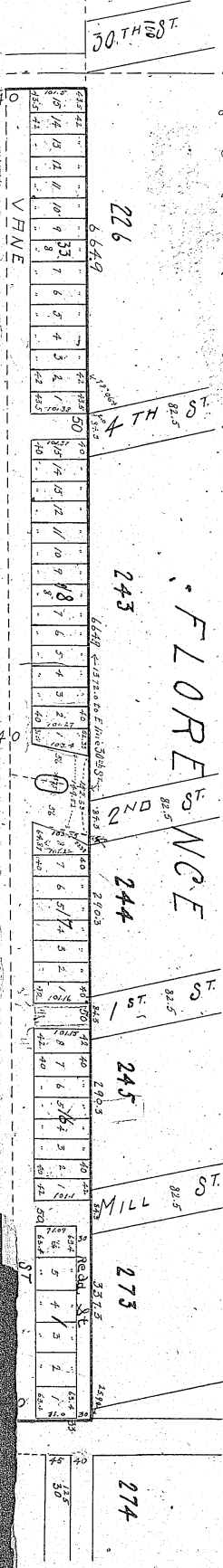
MINNE LUSA

I hereby certify that I have accurately surveyed and staked the lots, blocks, streets and avenues of Minnie Lusa an addition to the city of Omaha as shown by this plat and described as follows: Commencing at a pt. on the North City Limits Line 762.5 ft. North and 35 ft. West of the North East corner of Sec. 33, T16 R 15 E. of the 6th P.M., thence South along the West line of 24th Street 2085.0 ft. to the North East corner of Miller Park, thence West along the North line of Miller Park 2578.1 ft. to the East line of 30th Street, thence North along the East line of 30th Street 2085.6 ft. to the North City Limits Line, thence East along the North City Limits Line 2576.7 ft. to the West Line of 24th Street or point of beginning, being all of the North 1/4 of the North East 1/4 of Sec. 33, T16 R 15 and that part of the South East 1/4 of Sec. 28, T16 R. 15 lying South of the North City Limits Line, except 35 ft. strips on 24th Street and 30th Street previously dedicated to the City of Omaha.

I have set iron stakes at all block and lot corners. *C. C. Mueselring, Surveyor.*

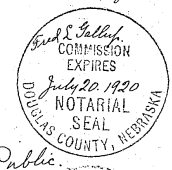

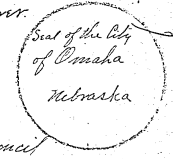
