RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT

I, MISSION HOMES, INC., in consideration of the sum of

Valuable Consideration _____ Dollars (\$ ---),

receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant to the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the perpetual right to construct, operate, and maintain its telephone and telegraph lines consisting of poles, wires, cables, fixtures, and anchors, together with the power to extend to any other company the right to use, jointly with the grantor, any pole placed pursuant to the provisions hereof, upon or adjacent to that certain piece of real estate hereinafter described, in the following manner:

Poles to be located in a east-west line 15' north of the south property line of Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, & 12 and Anchors on the north-south line between Lots 2-3, 6-7, & 10-11.

together with the right to trim any trees along said lines where necessary to secure a clearance of at least four feet for the wires.

The foregoing right is granted upon the express condition that the Telephone Company will assume liability for all damage to the hereinafter described property caused by said Company's failure to use due care in its exercise of the granted right.

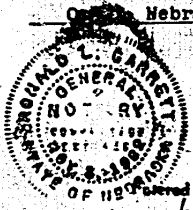
