SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 544B

WHEREAS, Karl A. Witt has submitted an application designated as Special Permit No. 544B for authority to amend the Northside Village Community Unit Plan to construct and develop 23 single family lots on property located on the southeast corner of Hartley and Fairfield Streets, and legally described to wit:

Outlot 'A', Northside Village 3rd Addition Replat, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the real property adjacent to the area included within the plot plan for this development will not be adversely affected; and

WHEREAS, said plot plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth are consistent with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal Code to promote the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

That the application of Karl A. Witt, hereinafter referred to as "Permittee", to construct and develop an additional 23 single-family lots within the existing community unit plan be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section 27.63.320 of the Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that construction and development of said lots be in strict compliance with said application, the plot plan, and the following additional express terms, conditions, and requirements:

- 1. This permit authorizes a maximum of 375 dwelling units within Northside Village Community Unit Plan.
 - Before receiving building permits:

02		permanent reproducible final site plan as approved by the

- The construction plans shall comply with the approved plans.
- The final plat of Northside Village 5th Addition must be approved by the City.
- The City Council must approve Change of Zone 2575.
- Before occupying this Community Unit Plan, all development and construction shall comply with the approved plans.
- 4. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, successors, and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
