AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEY IN BLOCK FORTY ONE (41) TOWNSITE OF RALSTON. AN ADDTION AS SURVEYED PLATTED AND RECORDED IN DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

WHEREAS a petition has been received from the owners of all the property surrounding the alley above described, wherein the owners of said and waives all damages that may be occasioned by the vacation of said alley betwen Block Forty One (41):

THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RALSTON. NEBRASKAK:

SECTION 1. That the alley in Block Forty One (41) Townsite of Ralston. an addition as surveyed, platted and recorded, in Douglas County, Nebraska be and hereby is vacated: The vacating of the property herein described and the reversion thereof, shall be subject to the condition and limitation that there is reserved to the Village of Ralston, the right to maintain, operate, repair and renew sewers now existing therein and in the fufture and also the right to authroized the extension of a sewer or any other public utility to be constructed, an maintained, or repair, and renew and operate now existing or hereinafter installed water mains, pole lines, conduits and other similar services or equipment above or and below the surface of the ground for the purpose of serving the general public or abutting property; and the right so reserved shall also include such lateral connections or branche lines as may be ordered, desired or permitted by the Village, and to enter upon the premises to accomplish the above purpose at any and all times.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after itspassage and publication as provided by law.
