

WHEREAS, it has been duly declared necessary by Ordinance of the Village of Ralston, to vacate the South seventeen and one-half feet (S. 17 1/2 ft.) of Maywood Street from seventy-fifth Street to Miller Avenue; the North Seventeen and one-half feet (N. 17 1/2 ft.) of Maywood Street from Seventy-fifth Street to Miller Avenue; the South seventeen and one-half feet (S. 17 1/2 ft.) of State Street from Seventy-fifth Street to Miller Avenue; the north seventeen and one-half feet (N. 17 1/2 ft.) of State Street from Seventy-fifth Street to Miller Avenue; the west seventeen and one-half feet (W. 17 1/2 ft.) of Seventy-sixth Street from Oakwood Street to Main Street; and the East seventeen and one-half feet (E. 17 1/2 ft.) of Seventy-sixth Street from Oakwood Street to Main Street, within the Village of Ralston, and

WHEREAS, five (5) disinterested householders of said Village were duly appointed by the Village Board of the Village of Ralston to ascertain, determine, assess and appraise the damages sustained by any person or persons on account of said vacation, and said appraisers took oath as required by the Ordinance of said Village, and made assessment and appraisement and filed the same in writing with the Village Clerk of the Village of Ralston for confirmation, and said assessment and appraisement has been duly adopted and confirmed by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Ralston, and all other requirements of law relating to the vacation of said parts of said streets have been fully complied with, Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RALSTON, NEBRASKA,

Sec. I. That the south seventeen and one-half feet (S. 17 1/2 ft.) of Maywood Street from Seventy-fifth Street to Miller Avenue; the north Seventeen and one-half feet
