- 3. The warrant and the bond principal indebtedness of the District is as follows, as of the preceding June 30: construction fund and general fund warrant principal indebtedness is \$0.00; the bond principal indebtedness is \$10,265,000.00.
- 4. The current bond tax levy and the current operating levy of the District as of December 31, 2020, are as follows: current bond tax levy is .590000 per \$100 of valuation; the current operating levy is .160000 per \$100 of valuation.
- The District is required by statute to levy special assessments on property in the District to the full extent of special benefits arising by reason of improvements installed by it.
