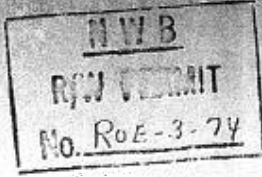

SUBORDINATION OF EASEMENT

This Indenture, made this 11th day of January 1974, by and between the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, hereinafter called the Grantor, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Iowa, with its principal place of business in Omaha, Nebraska, and the United States of America, hereinafter called the Government;

Whereas, the Government has, under authority of Public Law 90-483, 90th Congress, approved 13 August 1968, undertaken the development of a flood control project known as Papillion Creek and Tributaries Lakes Project, hereinafter called the Project; and

Whereas, the Grantor has certain statutory easement rights within the Project Area to erect poles and string wires thereon and/or bury cables in, over, and along the public highway right-of-way along the South Side of the Southwest Quarter (SW¹/₄) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄), the East Side of the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄), the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄), and the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄) of the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄), all in Section Thirty-five (35), and the South Side of the Southwest Quarter (SW¹/₄) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄) of Section Twenty-six (26), all in Township 16 North, Range Eleven (11) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Nebraska.

Whereas, it is necessary in the construction, completion and enjoyment of the Government of said Project, that flowage rights be acquired by the Government over the land in, on and across which Grantor has said right to erect poles and string wires, and/or bury cables;

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), in hand paid, and other further valuable consideration as set forth in Contract No. DACM45-73-C-0004, the Grantor does hereby subordinate its rights in said land herein described and set forth to the perpetual and permanent right of the Government and its assigns to intermittently and occasionally flood said land to an elevation of 1121.0 feet mean sea level.

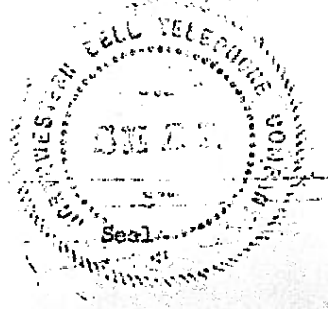
To Have and to Hold the rights and easements herein granted unto the Government and its assigns forever, for the purposes aforesaid.
