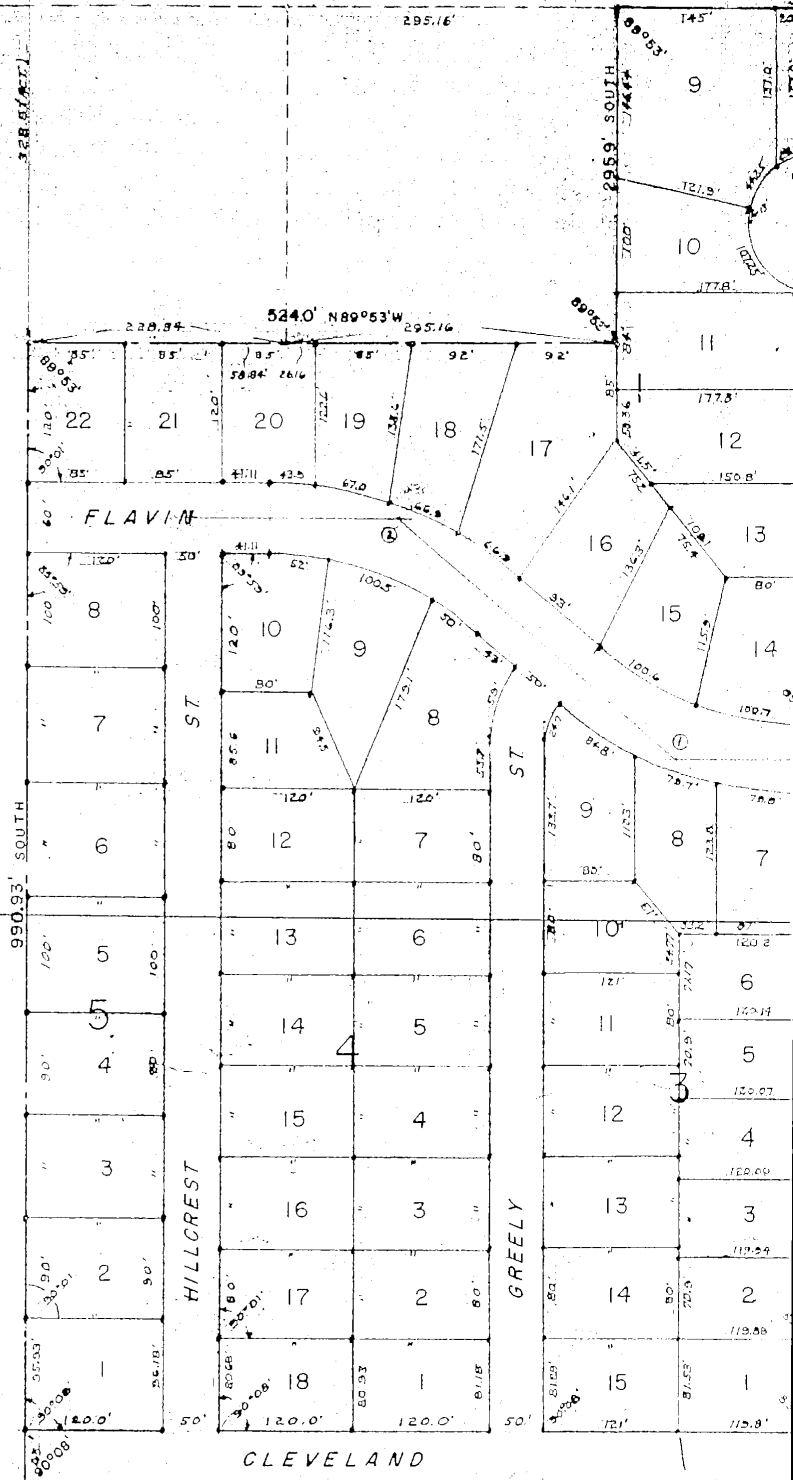

ALL CURVE DIST. ARE ARC MEASUR.

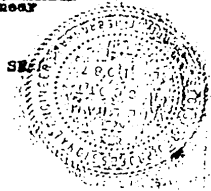
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that I have accurately surveyed and staked with iron pipe all corners of lots, streets, angle points, and the ends of all curves in Suburban Homes, a subdivision being a part of the NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 12, Range 10, East of the 6th Principal Meridian, Douglas County, Nebraska, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 33 feet South and 401.0 feet West of the NE Corner (of said Section 12), thence North 69°53' East a distance of 349.3 feet to existing iron pipe, thence South 295.9 feet, thence North 69°53' West a distance of 524.0 feet, thence South 920.62 feet, thence South 69°52' East a distance of 572.8 feet, thence North a distance of 1227.09 feet to point of beginning.
