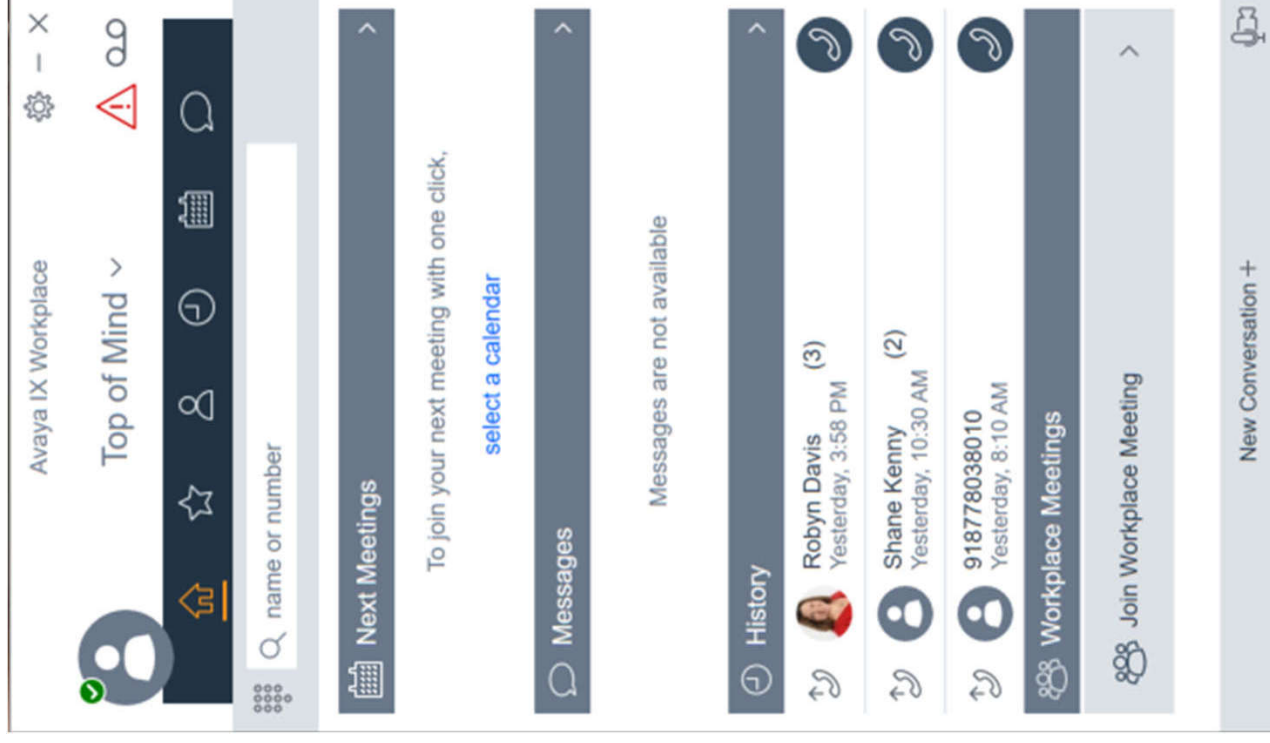


# Welcome to your new softphone system

When you turn on your computer, Avaya will open automatically. You will already be connected and ready to go.

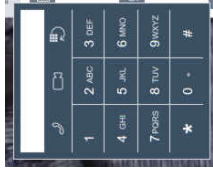
You can resize this to whatever size works best. You can also minimize it and find it on your taskbar at the bottom of your monitor.



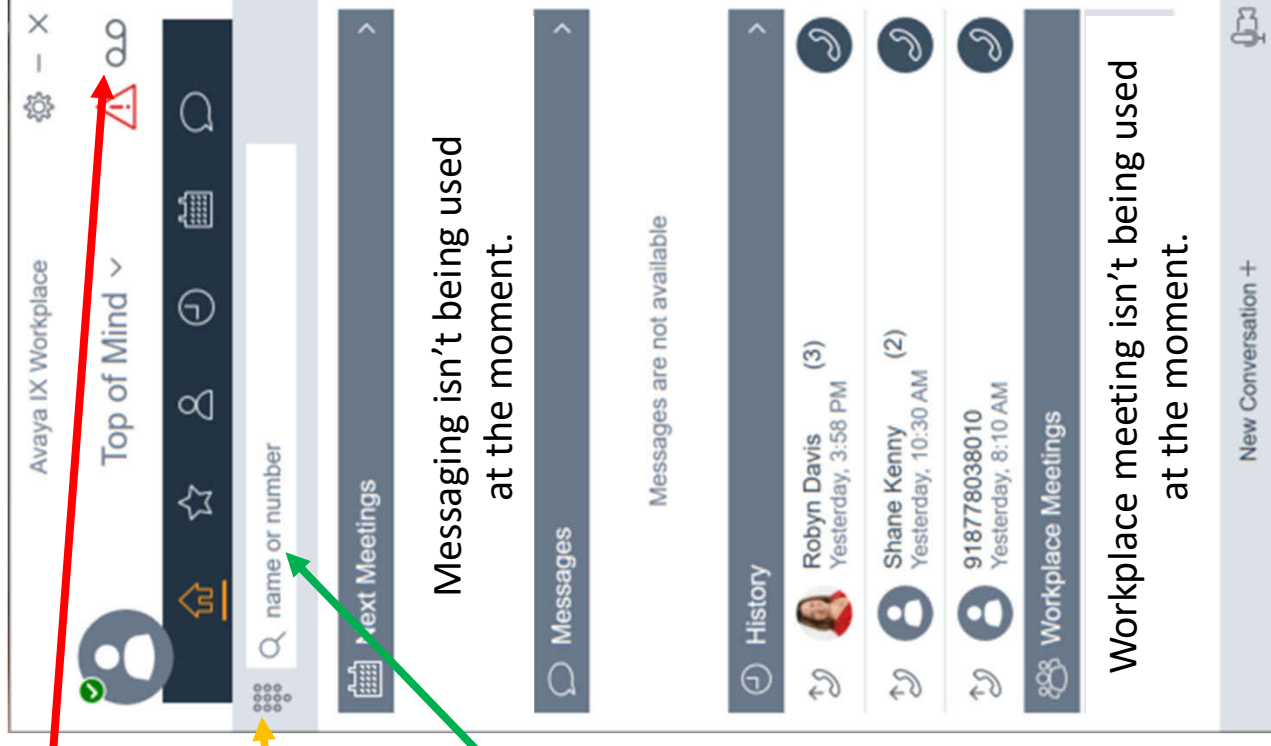
This is the Home Screen. From here you can

- **View Voicemails** - If you have voicemails this icon will be surrounded by a red circle. Just click to access voicemail menu. Headset is needed.

- **Open the keypad** – You can use your keyboard to type numbers in



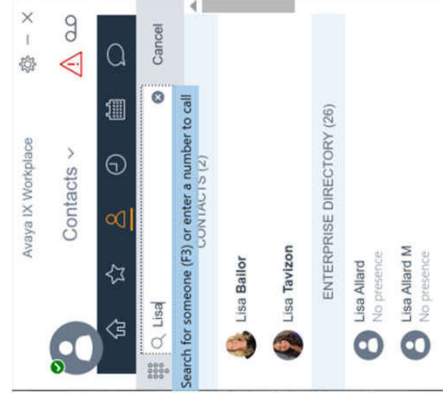
- **Name or number**– Just type the phone in the box and hit enter to dial or persons name to look them up.

Messages are not available

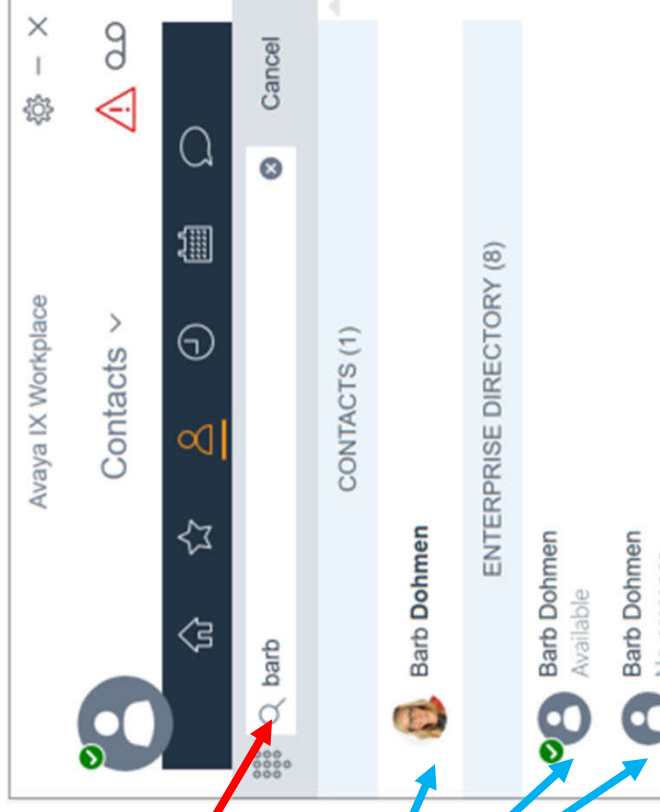
Workplace meeting isn't being used at the moment.



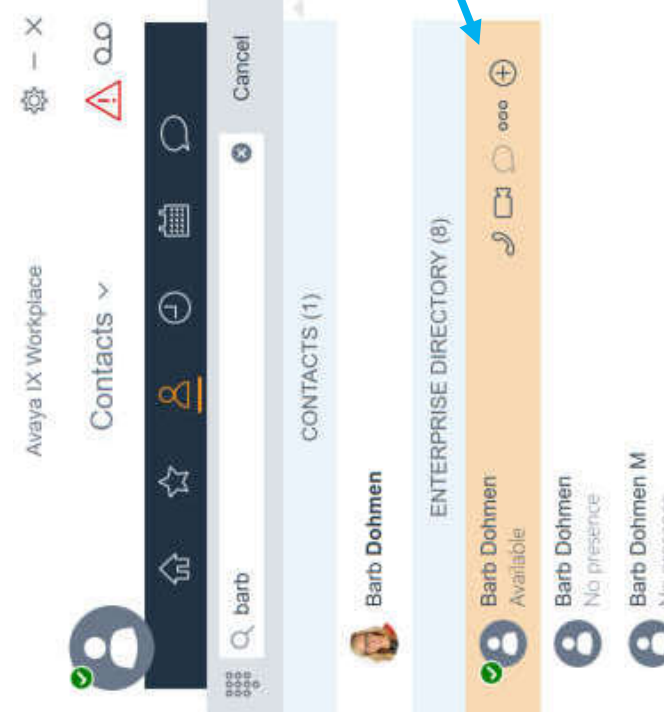

# To make a phone call

Type your customers name or number in the box.  
If it's a number, just hit enter to dial.  
Don't forget to add 9 for outside calls



Any entries with that name will show

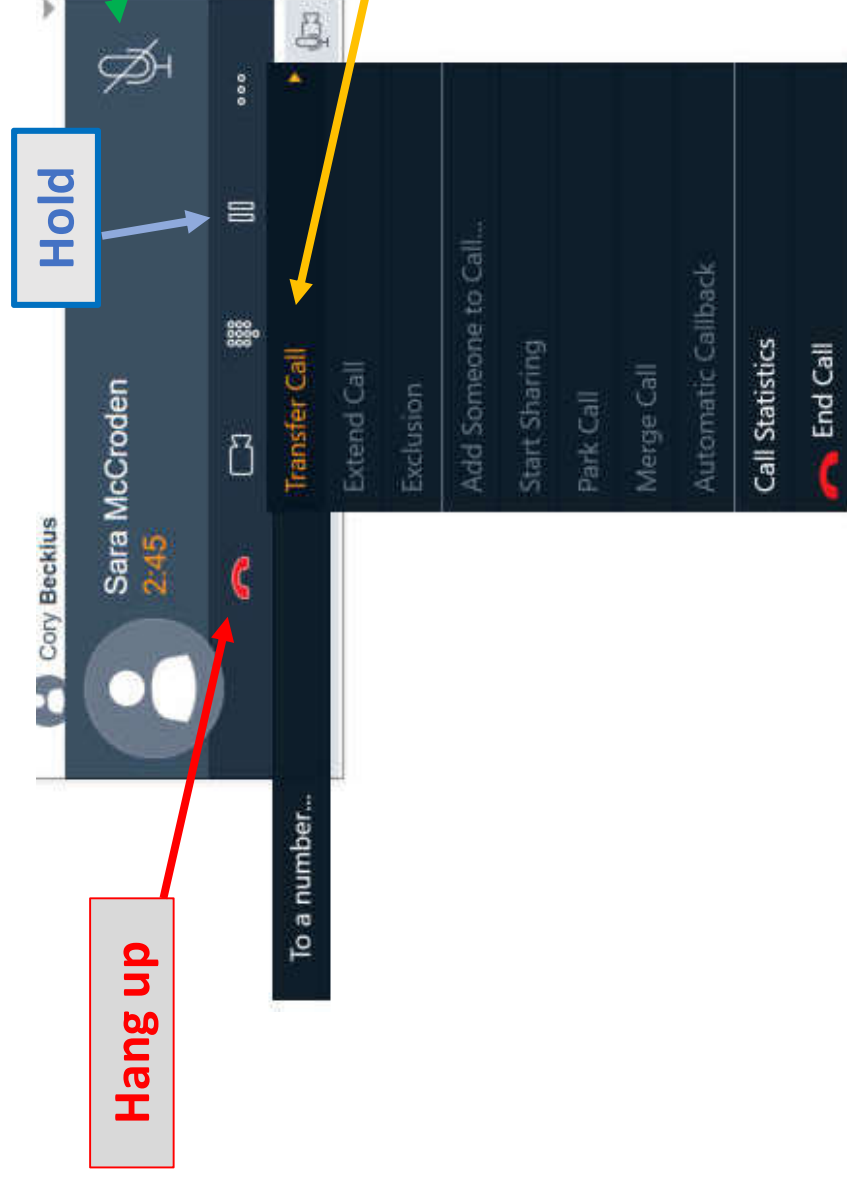


Move your pointer over any contact and it will turn orange and the options to call, video, chat and more will show up. Click on the phone icon and the primary number will be called.

Click on the **☰** and you'll have more numbers pop up. Click the phone icon next to the number you'd like to call. The number with the dot is the primary number



The bottom of your Avaya app will show who you are on a call with and the options you have.



**Hang up**

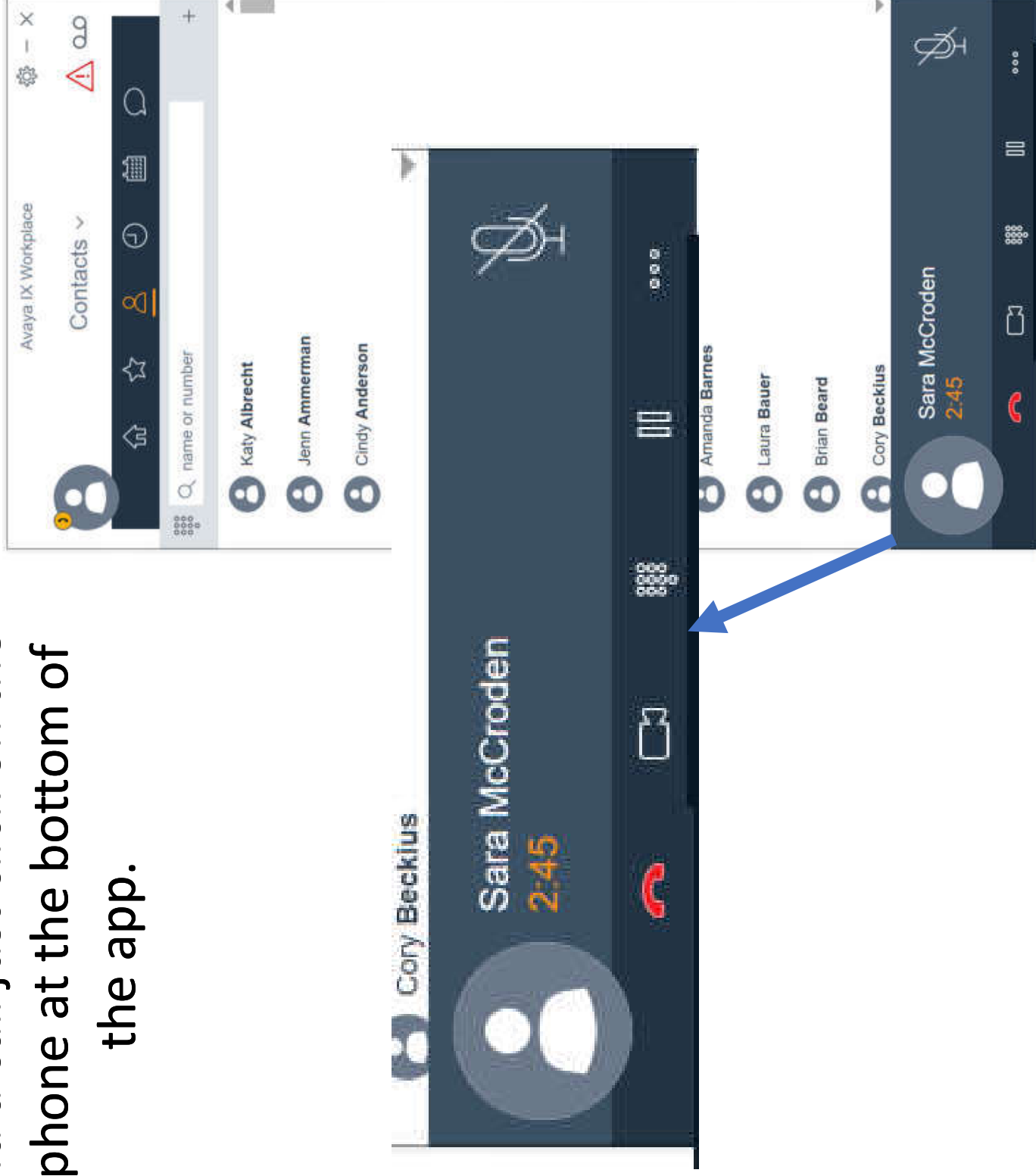

Select to a number and type the number you're transferring to. Can be an extension or a phone number (please remember to add 9) Hit enter to transfer.

To end a call just click on the red phone at the bottom of the app.



# Shortcuts!

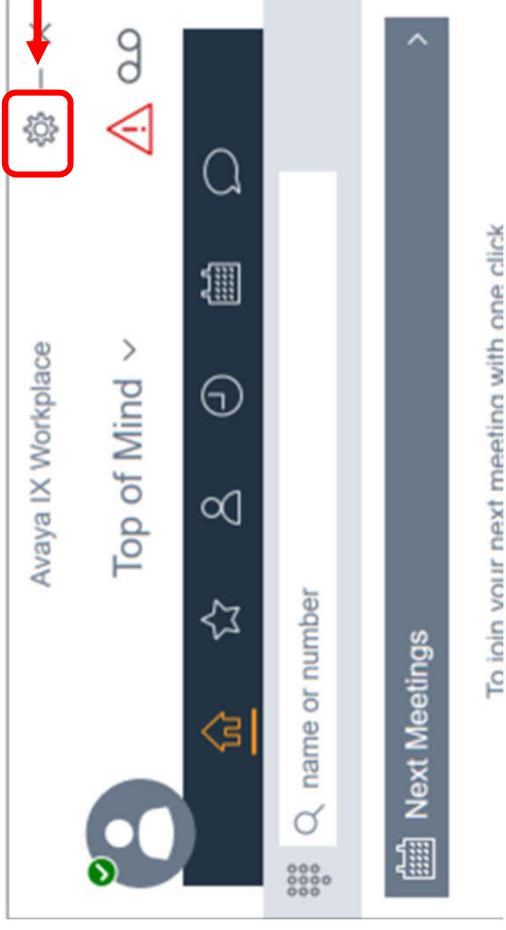
One of the best features is that you can create your own shortcuts!

Quick Overview (screen shots are on next slides)

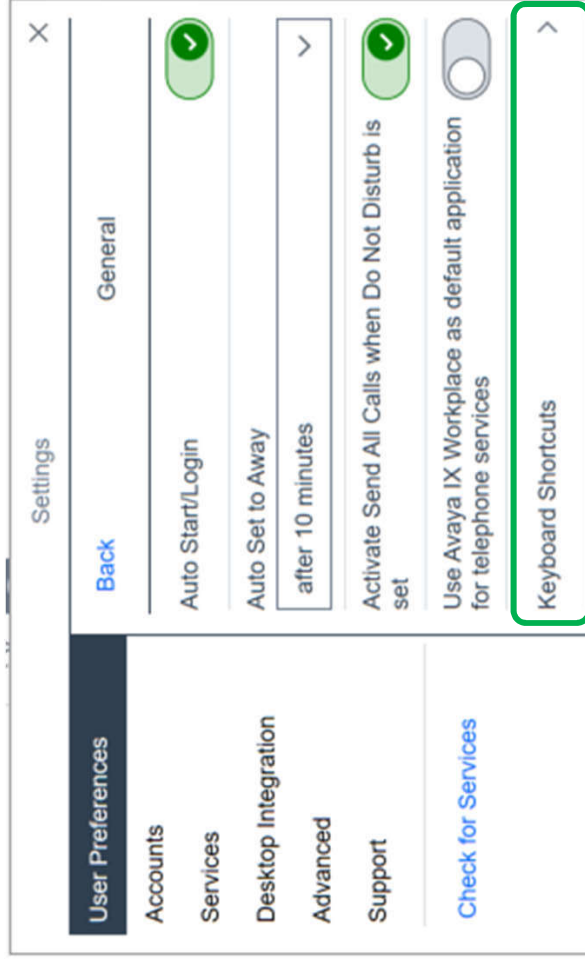
1. Open Settings
2. General
3. Keyboard Shortcuts
4. Press the key(s) you'd like for that shortcut
5. Toggle the Global button next to it
6. Click Done.
