The Permittee must submit an acceptable, revised, and a. 4 reproducible final plan and six copies. 5 The construction plans must conform to the approved plans. b. 6 The Permittee must submit to the City Clerk a deed for the 7 C. additional right-of-way for N. 70th Street and relinquish direct 8 vehicular access except at the driveway location shown on the 9 site plan for the community unit plan and pay the recording fee in 10 advance. 11 Before occupying the dwelling units all development and construction 3. 12 must be completed in conformance with the approved plans. 13 All privately-owned improvements must be permanently maintained by 4. 14 the Permittee or an appropriately established homeowners association approved by the City 15 Attorney. 16 The site plan approved by this permit shall be the basis for all 5. 17 interpretations of setbacks, yards, locations of buildings, location of parking and circulation 18 19 elements, and similar matters. The Permittee shall complete or post a bond, escrow or security 6. 20 agreement approved by the City Law Department to guarantee the completion of the drainage

facilities, landscape screens, and street trees, in conformance with the City Design Standards

and within the time periods specified in the Land Subdivision Ordinance for said improvements.

7. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, his successors, and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.

8. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
