- 4. All privately-owned improvements must be permanently maintained by the owner or an appropriately established homeowners association approved by the City Attorney.
- 5. The site plan approved by this permit shall be the basis for all interpretations of setbacks, yards, locations of buildings, location of parking and circulation elements, and similar matters.

The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the 7. City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
