RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a petition was signed by the owners of Lots 1 to 6 and 8 and 9 in Block 1, and Lots 1 to 18, inclusive, in Block 2, all in Webster's Addition, Sarpy County, Nebraska, as surveyed, platted and recorded, and Sub-Lot 3 of Sub-Lot 3, Abraham's Subdivision of Lot D, Section 14, Township 14, Range 13, Sarpy County, Nebraska, and has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Sarpy, Nebraska, petitioning the Board to vacate Oak Street, a platted street between Blocks 1 and 2, Webster's Addition, extending from the north line of Center Street to the south line of Sub-Lot 3 of Sub-Lot 3, Abraham's Subdivision of Lot D, and

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the platted alley in Block 2 of Webster's Addition extending from the North line of Center Street to the south line of Sub-Lot 3 of Sub-Lot 3, Abraham's Sub-Division of Lot D, and WHEREAS, said petition was signed by more than two-thirds of the owners of the property adjacent and abutting on said street and alley, and

WHEREAS, said street, alley and subdivision is not within an incorporated city or village, and

WHEREAS, said street or alley has not been used as a public way and is not required by the owners of the above described real estate for ingress or egress to any other property adjacent to and abutting on said street or alley, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and advantageous and to the best interests that said street and alley be vacated and that said property revert to the owners of adjacent and abutting real estate,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Oak Street, a platted street between Blocks 1 and Block 2 of Webster's Addition in the County of Sarpy, Nebraska, as surveyed, platted and recorded, extending from the north line of Center Street to the South line of Sub-Lot 3 of Sub-Lot 3, Abrahams' Subdvision of Lot D, be and the same is hereby vacated, and that the said vacated property revert to the owners of the property abutting said street, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the platted alley in Block 2 of Webster's Addition to the County of Sarpy, Nebraska, as surveyed, platted and recorded, extending from the north line of Center Street to the South line of Sub-Lot 3 of Sub-Lot 3, Abrahams Subdivision of Lot D in Section 14, Township 14, Range 13, Sarpy County, Nebraska, be and the same is hereby vacated and that said vacated property revert to the owners of the property abutting said alley.
