AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

WHEREAS, Developer did, on November 9, 1969 cause to be filed against such property Protective Covenants in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Nebraska in Book 904 at Page 647; and

WHEREAS, paragraph 21 thereof allows that for a period of ten following the twenty-third of September, 1989, the Developer shall have the right to amend, modify or supplement all or any portion of these Protective Covenants from time to time by executing and recording one or more duly acknowledged Amendments to Protective Covenants in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Nebraska.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned Developer does hereby delete and amend paragraph 6. Area. E. Multi-level (3 or more levels finished above grade) by deleting therefrom 1,700 square feet and inserting in its place and stead, 1,400 square feet for the above described lots.

The Protective Covenants at Book 904, Page 647 through Page 650 shall, in all other respects remain in full force and effect.
