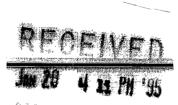

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that I have made a ground survey of the subdivision described herein and that temporary monuments have been placed on the boundary of the within plat, and that a bond has been furnished to the City of Omaha to ensure placing of permanent monuments and stakes at all corners of all lots, streets, angle points and ends of all curves in WYNNEWOOD 3RD ADDITION (Lots 1 thru 34, inclusive) being a replat of Lot 100, Wynnewood Ist Addition, a subdivision located in the West 1/2 of Section 35, Township 16 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M., Douglas County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 23, Wynnewood, a subdivision located in said West 1/2 of Section 35, said point also being on the North right-of-way line of Crown Point Avenue; thence S89°37'55"W (assumed bearing) along said North rightof-way line of Crown Point Avenue, a distance of 253.24 feet to the Southwesterly corner of said Lot 100, Wynnewood Ist Addition; thence along the Southerly line of said Lot 100, Wynnewood Ist Addition, on the following described courses; thence N00°10'58"W, a distance of 198.21 feet; thence N75°09'30"W, a distance of 64.07 feet; thence S89°39'33"W, a distance of 127.03 feet to a point on the West line of said Lot 100, Wynnewood Ist Addition; thence NOO°11'05"W along said West line of Lot 100, Wynnewood Ist Addition, a distance of 654.54 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot 100, Wynnewood Ist Addition, said point also being the Southwest corner of Lot 35, said Wynnewood Ist Addition; thence along the Northerly and Easterly lines of said Lot 100, Wynnewood Ist Addition, on the following described courses; thence N89°48'55"E, a distance of 150.00 feet; thence S00°11'05"E, a distance of 18.69 feet; thence N89°48'55"E, a distance of 124.18 feet; thence S46°09'15"E, a distance of 24.63 feet; thence S03°12'17"W, a distance of 157.65 feet; thence S14°34'39"W, a distance of 49.80 feet; thence S73°34'10"E, a distance of 180.00 feet; thence Southwesterly on a curve to the right with a radius of 950.00 feet, a distance of 46.87 feet, said curve having a long chord which bears \$17°50'38"W, a distance of 46.86 feet; thence \$70°44'35"E, a distance of 98.02 feet; thence S11°22'54"W, a distance of 36.53 feet; thence S21°58'32"W, a distance of 190.22 feet; thence S00°22'05"E, a distance of 286.26 feet to the point

DEDICATION

Know all men by these presents that we, Construction Sciences, Inc., owner, and FirsTier Bank, N.A. Omaha, mortgagee of the property described in the Certification of Survey and embraced within the plat, have caused said land to be subdivided into lots and streets to be numbered and named as shown, said subdivision to be hereafter known as WYNNEWOOD 3RD ADDITION (lots to be numbered as shown), and we do hereby ratify and approve of the disposition of our property as shown on the plat, and we do hereby dedicate to the public for public use the streets, avenues and circles, and we do hereby grant easements as shown on this plat, we do further grant a perpetual easement to the Omaha Public Power District, U.S. West Communications and any company which has been granted a franchise to provide a cable television system in the area to be subdivided, their successors and assigns, to erect, operate, maintain, repair and renew poles, wires, cables, conduits and other related facilities, and to extend thereon wires or cables for the carrying and transmission of electric current for light, heat and power and for the transmission of signals and sounds of all kinds including signals provided by a cable television system, and the reception on, over, through, under and across a five-foot (5') wide strip of land abutting all front and side boundary lot lines; an eight-foot (8') wide strip of land abutting the rear boundary lines of all lots; and a sixteen-foot (16') wide strip of land abutting the rear boundary lines of all exterior lots. The term exterior lots is herein defined as those lots forming the outer perimeter of the above-described addition. Said sixteen-foot (16') wide easement will be reduced to an eight-foot (8') wide strip when the adjacent land is surveyed, platted and recorded, and we do further grant a perpetual easement to Metropolitan Utilities District of Omaha, their successors and assigns, to erect, install, operate, maintain, repair and renew pipelines, hydrants and other related facilities, and to extend thereon pipes for the transmission of gas and water on, through, under and across a five-foot (5') wide strip of land abutting alkstreets. No permanent buildings or retaining walls shall be placed in the said easement ways, but the same may be used for gardens, shrubs, landscaping and other purposes that do not then or later interfere with the aforesaid uses or rights herein granted.
