Metropolitan Utilities District

THIS AGREEMENT, between The Metropolitan Utilities District,
first party, and Mary Cornaci, second party, Witnesseth:

That, for good and valuable consideration, a license, priv-
ilege or permit shall be granted to the second party, subject to the rules and regulations of
the said Metropolitan Utilities District in that behalf, to make a connection for the supply of
water to the premises on the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas,
state of Nebraska, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Lots 3 and 4, Bonfield and Lots 2, 3, 4, and 5 in Sub. Lot 14 and Lot 2 in Sub Lot 13,
Douglas county, Nebr.

IN CONSIDERATION of the foregoing, said second party, being the owner of the above-
described real estate, and Conservative Savings and Loan Assn., agrees, in the event said above-
described real estate shall be now or hereafter included in a Water Main District and become
subject to assessment for the extension of a water main in said District, that said second party
and said mortgagee will and do hereby waive all objections to the creation of said Water Main
District and to the levy and assessment of a special tax against said real estate to pay the cost
of said extension of a water main in said Water Main District; and that said second party will
re-connect the service herein provided for with any permanent service main installed by said
first party and at second party's expense.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD that this Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their
successors, grantees, heirs or representatives.
